



## Alumni in the State Generate Additional Impact

Since 1966, nearly 112,000 graduates have emerged with a degree or credential from North Hennepin Community College. These graduates are an integral part of the Minnesota workforce, impacting the economy not only through their spending but also through the extra earning power generated by their North Hennepin Community College degree.

Based on the estimated 33,904 North Hennepin Community College alumni in Minnesota from the past 10 years alone, alumni living and working in Minnesota are continuing to make a positive economic impact after graduation. Each year, North Hennepin Community College alumni generate \$125.1 million in economic impact for Minnesota and support and sustain 667 jobs. Over their 40-year career, North Hennepin Community College alumni will generate \$5 billion in the economy. These impacts are based on the added value of earning a degree or credential from North Hennepin Community College, not alumni full wages.



## in the Community and State
